## GENERAL INFORMATION

You are **ELIGIBLE TO VOTE** if you are a U.S. citizen, a legal resident of Washington State, and at least 18 years old by the date of the next election. You must be registered to vote at least 30 days before the election.

You can **REGISTER TO VOTE** at the County Courthouse, libraries, schools, manned fire stations, or when renewing your driver's license. **UPDATE YOUR REGISTRATION** if you move or change your name. You can also get the registration form online from the Mason County Auditor's office.

Mason County **VOTES BY MAIL**. Ballots are sent 20 days before the election (sooner to persons serving in the military or living overseas). They must be postmarked or hand delivered to the Auditor's office by the day of the election. If you have not received your ballot within five days of the election, call the Mason County Auditor's office (360-427-9670 or 360-275-4255 Ext. 470).

**FURTHER INFORMATION** about voting or voter registration is available by calling the Mason County Auditor's office or online.

**PRIMARY ELECTIONS** are held the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday in August. Washington primaries use a "top two" system, where the two candidates who receive the most votes qualify for the general election. Candidates are not required to state a party preference.

**GENERAL ELECTIONS** (including state ballot issues) are held on the 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday after the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in November.

**SPECIAL ELECTIONS** may be held at other specified times.

Federal, State and County officials (both partisan and non-partisan) are elected in even years. Also, PUD Commissioners (non-partisan) are elected in even years. City and District officials (all non-partisans) are elected in odd numbered years.
